Can I apply for a scholarship?

You may apply for a scholarship if you meet the following criteria:

- Must be a United States citizen and attend school in the city of Port Arthur
- Must be a graduating senior in Spring 2022
- Must be graduating with a GPA of 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale (weighted)
- Must provide evidence of the completion of 35 hours of community service while in high school
- Must be enrolled in an accredited college or university by the Fall of 2022

How will awards be distributed?

First Generation (1): One scholarship will be awarded to a student whose parent or legal guardian did not enroll in post-secondary education.

First Generation and Attend a HBCU (2): Two scholarships will be awarded to students whose parent or legal guardian did not enroll in post-secondary education.

What is the deadline to apply?

- 6. How would you rate the applicant's potential for future personal achievement? Why?
- 7. Additional comments

Questionnaire

The requested information in this section should be <u>typed on a separate sheet of paper</u> and submitted with application and other required materials.

1. SCHOLASTICS

List all scholastic achievements, awards and honorable recognition earned during high school

2. SCHOOL / EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

List your membership in any organizations, clubs or sports activities and describe your involvement throughout high school (not elementary or middle school). Please note the length of time you have participated in these activities and whether or not you held a leadership position.

3. SERVICE TO YOUR COMMUNITY

List your membership in or any volunteer community services you are actively involved in or have participated in for your community. Also, list the length of time you have been involved with these programs and if you held a leadership position. Please only list your community involvement throughout high school.

4. ESSAY (300 word minimum 500 word maximum)

Answer one of the following questions:

- 1. Where do you see yourself in ten years?
- 2. Describe a time where you were faced with a challenge and describe how you overcame it.
